As Manager, you will be a strong facilitator and networker, with an ability to welcome and encourage schools, friends and the local community of ErinEarth to continue to deliver and participate in these programs.

The Manager of ErinEarth will possess the following knowledge, experience and qualifications:

- Demonstrated commitment to ErinEarth's values of sustainability, spirituality, social
  justice, and reconciliation with First Nations People, and experience working in these
  or related fields
- Demonstrated ability to lead the implementation of a Strategic Plan
- Demonstrated ability to work with volunteers, and a capacity to maintain and build a volunteer network
- Demonstrated leadership and management skills, and a capacity to be a 'hands-on' leader in a small organisation
- Demonstrated experience in organisational administration, day to day running of organisations (including maintenance and improvements), supervision of staff and meeting compliance reporting requirements
- Commitment to Work Health and Safety principles and procedures, and to principles of and procedures of Equal Employment Opportunity
- Comfortable working in an environment that upholds the ErinEarth heritage of the Presentation Sisters.
- Tertiary qualifications in a field related to the work of ErinEarth or equivalent experience
